*Confession & Forgiveness

P: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. C: Amen

C: Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord. C: Amen
