A year ago, I sat in my house, depressed and frustrated as I dealt with a broken ankle. When I look back at that time, I often wonder how I did not go crazy and lose my mind.

Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staff— they comfort me.

Psalm 23:4

Brokenness. It is something that we all share, a feeling of not being whole, of being shattered by pain, guilt, sin, and grief. A relationship ends because of shattered trust. A loved one is taken by cancer. We feel consumed by the guilt of our own actions. Depression and anxiety and mental illness threaten to consume us. Our body is in pain that seems to never cease. Brokenness.

Restore us, O God; let your face shine, that we may be saved.

Psalm 80:3

We try really hard to hide our brokenness, to hide our pain and suffering from others. We say "fine" when asked how we are. We put a positive spin on every event even if in the midst of it feels like we are in a prison of despair, conflict, and darkness. We feel alone, cut off from others and most especially our Savior Jesus Christ. It feels as if love and joy has been erased from the world, that we are sick and will never be well again.

When Jesus heard this, he said to them, 'Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick; I have come to call not the righteous but sinners.'

Jesus Christ has come for the broken. Jesus has come for the suffering. Jesus has come for the lost. Jesus has come for me. And Jesus has come for you. He has come to restore, to give hope, to bring light, to take the burdens and the pain and lighten our load. Jesus has come to love us broken people.

The LORD is near to the brokenhearted, and saves the crushed in spirit. Psalm 34:18

It is ok to be broken. Do not be ashamed of your brokenness. Rather, trust in the Son of God who has come to heal you of that brokenness. Have faith in the one who willingly takes your burdens. See the hope, healing, life, and strength that is given to you by a gracious Savior.

Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.






