Not my own mistakes, not my own ego, not the things of this world. I will always have a shepherd named Jesus. A shepherd who will give his life for mine. A shepherd who will search for me when I am lost. A shepherd who will guide me along right pathways.

Jesus is your shepherd too and this shepherd never gives up on you. This shepherd calls to you every day, calls to you messages of forgiveness, hope, life and salvation. This shepherd guides you on the mountaintops and in the valleys, in the good and the bad. Trust in this shepherd. Allow yourself to be led. Have faith in the Lord, Jesus Christ, who gives you eternal life. May the Lord shepherd all of us and shepherd this collection of loved and saved sinners called Trinity Lutheran Church.







## PATRIOTIC PINWHEEL

### What you need:

- Decorated card stock square (5" x 5")
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- 2 one-inch circles of card stock
- Glue
- Pipe cleaner (3 inches)
- Drinking straw



### What you do:
