And when you were dead in trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive together with him, when he forgave us all our trespasses, erasing the record that stood against us with its legal demands.

He set this aside, nailing it to the cross.

Colossians 2:13-14

As March begins we begin the season of Lent. During this season of Lent, in our Wednesday night worship services, we will hear from some of the forgotten disciples, followers of Christ that aren't the big name superstars like Peter or John. We will hear their stories as we worship the Son of God who journeys to the cross.

At the same time, Lent is a reflective time. A time to think about our faith and life. We will use spiritual practices like worship, prayer, and giving to strengthen our faith. It is also a time of repentance where we come honestly to our Lord about our missteps, mistakes, and sins. But we do not do this with a heavy heart because we have a forgiving and merciful God.

In the reading from Colossians above, we are reminded that God has forgiven us of our sins. These sins have been nailed to the cross of Christ and when we see that cross we see a symbol of the forgiveness, mercy, and love of God. For the Son of God went to the cross to not only forgive us, but to give us new life. We are made alive together by what Jesus has done for us. So when we come to Jesus with our confession, our repentance, our grief is replaced with joy and our sadness with hope. We have forgiveness in the Lord!

Even better, our sins are erased. When someone hurts us, we often don't forget that pain and never forget the wrong that was done to us. But the Lord forgets those sins. Every day in Christ we have a fresh start. Every day in Christ we have that promise of forgiveness and new life. Our past missteps are set aside.

Make this season of Lent not only an opportunity to be strengthen in faith, but to also set aside all the guilt that you are carrying from your past mistakes. Set aside the enmity and grudges you have against some else and place them all at the foot of the cross of Christ. Remember that you are forgiven, loved, and renewed by the Son of God, the Messiah, Jesus Christ your Lord. For that we can say, "Thanks be to God!"




