June 2020

Into your hand I commit my spirit; you have redeemed me, O Lord, faithful God. Psalm 31:5

One of the things we have all struggled with during this time of quarantine; other than cancellations, school at home, work at home, and all the rest, is a loss of control. Every day we deal with so many unknowns; most especially, when can we do the things we love and do them safely without worrying about masks, social distancing, and the like? We keep wondering if the things we have scheduled will happen like vacations, trips, weddings, and the like. The loss of control, of not knowing, drives us **C R A Z Y**. I know it drives ME crazy as I like control. I like plans. I like to KNOW. My guess is that you are the same way.

Here, in this Psalm, we see the Psalmist is ready to give up their life to the Lord. They are willing to give up control to God who is faithful. Who redeems. Who saves. 

Dear Trinity Members,

First off, we want to say thank you for your support of Trinity over these past two months. We thank you for joining us for worship online, drive-thru communion, viewing and sharing vide-os on Facebook and YouTube, and for your generous financial support. We are so grateful for your faith, support, and prayers and we are keeping each and every one of you in prayer as well.




