- **orange** = God's power to deliver

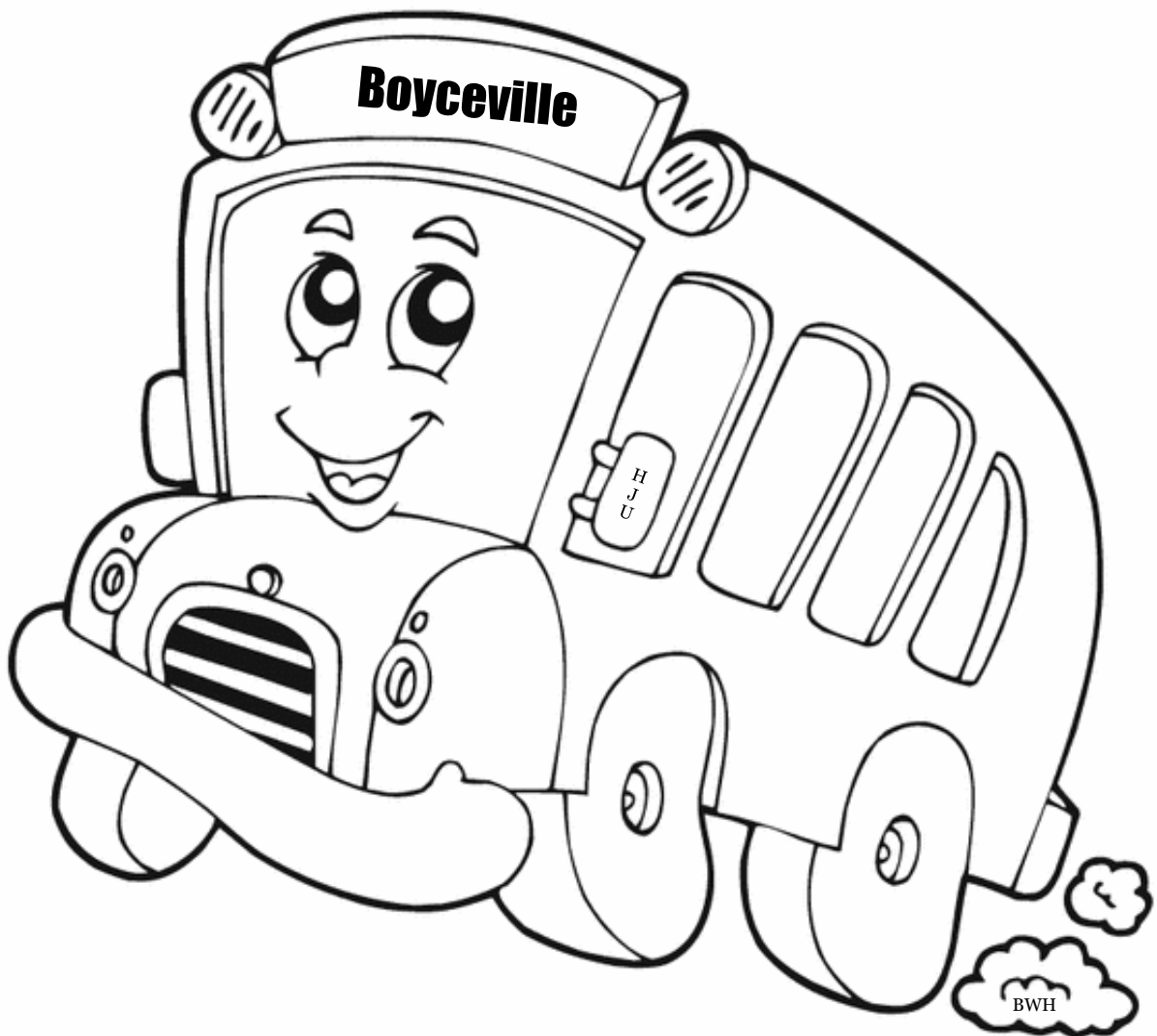
