When I was in high school, we had a phrase that was posted in our locker room and the weight room we used. It said, "Pain is temporary, pride is forever." It was one of those phrases that was meant to inspire you, to keep going in the midst of pain and difficulty, of putting your best out there. A sense that the pain you were feeling as you were lifting that weight would be fleeting, but the pride of doing your best, of trying to maximize all you can be, would be the stuff that really lasted.

I sometimes think about that phrase in my own life. If I'm really tired or hurting, when life seems incredibly busy and overwhelming, I sometimes tell myself that all of the pain, aggravation, stress, is just temporary and the result will be all worth it. To keep going even when I want to throw in the towel or give up.

These verses from Psalm 30 reminds me of that phrase on the locker room wall. The difference here is that what we receive from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is greater than anything we can accomplish ourselves. We may experience grief and sorrow, weeping in the night, but in the Lord, there is joy that is always there. Joy in knowing that death has no power over us. Joy in knowing that we are not alone. Joy in knowing that we have a promise of forgiveness, life, and salvation. Why? Because we have Jesus. Because Jesus has died and risen from the grave for us.

As we enter May, winter is a fleeting memory. The weather is warmer, the flowers are blooming, cabins are being made ready, fishing boats being prepared, and golf clubs are out and ready to be used (that one is for me!). We have joy because of the blessedness of spring. There is renewal in the earth and renewal in our lives. Our bodies, mind, and spirit are renewed by the grace and mercy of Jesus Christ. It is why we can sing praises. It is why we give thanks. Pain is temporary. God's love in Jesus Christ is forever.

Today, take heart knowing that in Christ we are being renewed every day. Remember that any pain and suffering you are experiencing today is only temporary and that you are not alone. Your Savior is with you. Your Lord loves you. And in the Lord, you can always find joy and new life. For that we can say, "Thanks be to God!" Amen

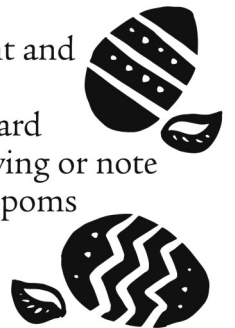
Egg- cellent bouquet
