Being part of the Men's Band is one of my favorite things I get to do as pastor of this congregation. I enjoy the laughter, even when it is at my expense, the friendship, and of course making music. I've learned a lot being in the band and one of the things is what is most important about being in a band. It isn't technical musical skill (though that helps), but rather it is the importance of listening. Listening to the voices of the other band members, listening to the beat and to the instruments, to the way the music flows and moves. We listen to each other so that we are in synch, so we can harmonize and compliment each other, and so we all end the song at the same time!

I must admit that I am a better talker than a listener. Being in the band has made me a better listener, made me put my own stuff in the background and try to listen to those I'm playing with. And in life, I try to listen to the what the Lord is saying to me. I think of this verse from John 10:27: *"My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me."* Our Lord Jesus Christ speaks to us. Guides us with his Holy Spirit, reminds us of all that Christ has done for us. Jesus speaks a word of truth, of hope, of faith, of love. But so often we let the other songs of life distract us, most especially our own song of selfishness and greed. We can miss our great shepherd speaking to us. Singing to us. Singing us a song of faith and love and new life.

We must practice listening. We must take a moment from the rat race of our lives to hear the song of our loving Savior. How do we do this? When we pray to our God, we take a moment to hear God speaking back to us. When we hear the word of scripture, no matter how, we are attentive to the way Spirit is speaking through that word. When we gather together with others, we listen to God speaking through them and be attentive to the songs they are singing. When we enjoy God's creation, we listen to the song coming through the trees, the grass, the flowers, the water. Our Savior is speaking to us in many and various ways, sharing a song with us so that we would join, adding our own harmony to God's melody of faith, hope, and love.

Take a moment to listen. Hear the voice of your shepherd calling you. Singing to you. Hear that voice and follow it and know that voice is sung for you and your voice is invited to join in the song. For that we can say, "Thanks be to God!" Amen
