This November, as you give thanks for all the blessings of life, take a moment to give thanks for the little things in life that bring you joy and show you that you are loved. Give thanks for those small moments when you know that you are cared for. After all, our Savior Jesus Christ reminds us every day that we are loved, and it is often in the small things, the small blessings, the small moments of contentment and peace that remind us that we are loved. I give thanks for the people in my life that show me that I'm loved and the ways God works in and through them to remind me that I am loved by my Savior as well. I give thanks for the small acts of kindness and love, like a dish of stuffing, and pray that I would go out into the world and show others the love of God through small acts of my own. And I hope that you do to.

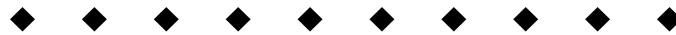

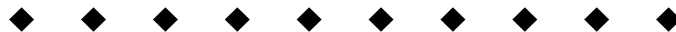

them to others you know who may need them.

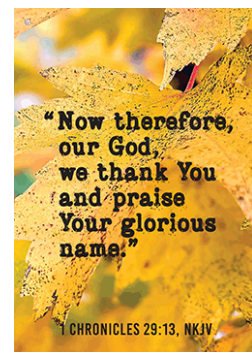

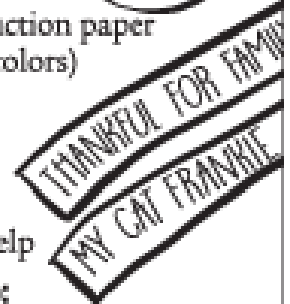
## Links of GRATITUDE
