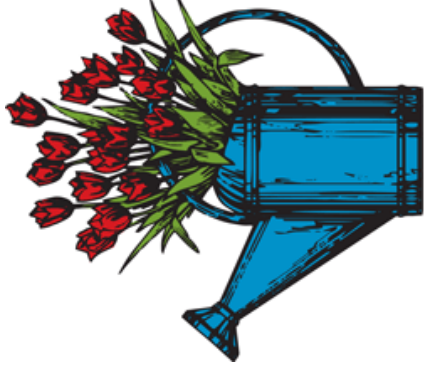

<sup>7</sup>Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7

I must admit, I can be a little bit of a worry wort. I get anxious. I like to think that most of the time, this anxiousness, this nervous energy, can be a great positive for me. I still get a little flutter in my stomach before I start a sermon. I get anxious before I start umpiring a game or when I'm announcing at football. I get anxious a bit when I get ready to speak in a meeting or leading a group. I get anxious right before we start playing at a Men's Band concert. That nervous energy can help keep me focused and sharp and even provide an energy boost when I'm tired.

But it can also debilitate me. I get anxious in a close game for the Bears or Cubs or Wild, causing me more pain and suffering than I need. At really big events, like Easter and Christmas Eve worship services, it can make me short and too blunt with others. There are times at night when my anxiety can keep me up or make it difficult for me to calm down. I know that my anxiety is about control, but it is also about feeling like a failure. Will I fail at this task? Will I make a mistake? Will I let everybody down? Have you ever had feelings like that?

That is why this verse from 1 Peter means a lot. We all have anxieties and fears. But we have a Savior in Jesus Christ who cares for us. Who will take our anxieties, our worries, our cares, and defeat them on the cross for us. This Savior says to us: "Do not worry, I got this. I got your back."

So often we think we are inadequate. It is that sinful nature in us, that nagging doubt that wants to say, "You aren't good enough. You aren't smart enough. No one likes you." (credit to Stuart Smalley from SNL for that). But it is true. We often feel those things and so our anxiety grows, our worry grows, our hopelessness grows.

But our Savior, through his death and resurrection, tells that we are worthy. We are good enough. We are liked. In fact, we are loved. Loved by a Savior who gave his life for us. Loved by a Savior that promises to be with us always. Loved by a Savior who sends the Holy Spirit to guide us and remind us. Remind us that God in Jesus Christ has our back. Will lift us up. Every day and always.

Place your trust in Jesus. Lay your cares at his cross. Cast your anxiety on him. For Jesus Christ cares for you, loves you, and will be with you always. For that we can say, "Thanks be to God!" Amen

**What you need:**

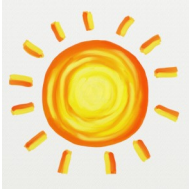
- White paper

- Glue



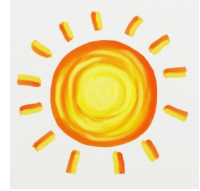
**What you do:**
