One of the jokes that we have in the Men's Band is that we even though we have played some of our songs probably at least a thousand times, we still forget how to start them. We might even forget how they might go. Why? Well, when you don't practice them, you forget them. I'm sure you have heard the phrase "practice makes perfect." You have to practice something to get to get it right, to remember it. I thought of that phrase as school gets back in session. Our kids have to remember how to use their brains again after a summer of being out of school and out of routine. Families have to get back into the groove of a school schedule. Even us, as a church, have to get back into the routine after our summer. I even had to do some remembering when I came back from sabbatical and being gone for a lot of the summer.

The same is true for our faith life. When we don't practice our faith, we forget it. We forget about the love of God for us in Jesus Christ. We forget about the hope and forgiveness we have received in Jesus. We forget that we are children of God and that through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ we have the promise of eternal life. We forget that we have a calling to serve our neighbors and care for the poor and needy. We forget that we are a part of this thing we call the church, the family of God, and that each of us has gifts that we can use to strengthen and lift up this body of Christ, each one of being an important part of this family.

It is why daily prayer is so important. It is why I do post those daily devotions on Facebook. It is why we offer worship online. It is why we encourage you to use your gifts out in the world. So that we would not forget. So that our faith would not get out of shape. So that we might remember the song of our salvation, a song of forgiveness and hope and grace and new life. I like to think of worship and prayer and daily devotion as those ways in which we recharge our faith so that we can live it out. Coming to the church to worship and to serve is the place where we remember who we are and what Christ has done for us so that we can go out and live out our faith every day and that our faith would remain strong as we go out into our everyday lives.

Just as we are getting back into the routines now that summer is over, maybe today is the day to get back into a routine of exercising your faith. Of remembering what Jesus Christ has done for you and the salvation you have received from him. Today is the day to start to pray again or read scripture again or maybe check out a worship service again if you have been away, whether it be in person or online. Maybe today is the day you decide to use your gifts in a new way or answer the call to serve your neighbor. Exercise your faith and remember the promises for you in Jesus Christ. It is never too late for your Savior is always waiting for you, for you are loved.

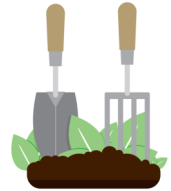

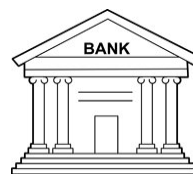

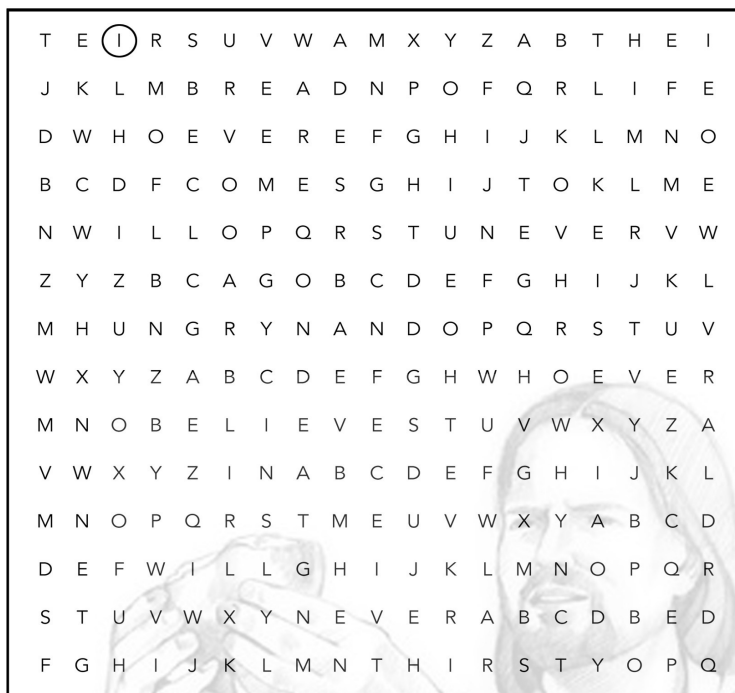
