# PASTOR'S PAGE

*"He has told you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?" Micah 6:8*

I think the above verse from Micah is a great way to think about Lent. Lent is a time of renewal of faith, of thinking about what the Lord has done for us, and how our faith impacts our lives and how we can impact the lives of others. One of the things we do in Lent is give back, and I want to take this moment to talk about how you, and we as the community of faith of Trinity Lutheran Church, can give back to our community.

In May we are going to hold an event to give back to our community. We are going to hold a breakfast in which we are going to invite our community, most especially those in need, to not only eat, but also an opportunity to pick up items that people need in every day life. And this is where you come in. We need to start collecting those items now. My hope is that, throughout these next two months, we can begin to collect those items so that when people come through these doors in May we can help to ease their burden and provide for their need. You will hear more details about the event as it gets closer and how you can help the event happen, but what we really need is your generosity in providing items.

This is what we are looking for:

soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant (men's and women), laundry detergent, dish soap, diapers, socks, men's underwear (all sizes), women's underwear (all sizes).

Please bring only new items and place them in the bins in the Narthex by the altar. This will not be a one time event. We hope to do this two or three times a year as a way to help our community, to partner with other organizations and supplement what they are doing, and to show our community that we care, especially the most vulnerable amongst us.

I hope that you will be generous in your giving and that you can participate in this new thing that we are doing. It is a chance to make a difference right here in Boyceville and though it might seem like a small thing, to provide some laundry detergent or a pair of socks or underwear to someone, to that person it makes a world of difference. Most especially, it is an act of faith in our Savior Jesus Christ, done in response to the one who has blessed us, loved us, and saves us every day.



# sweet soil



This snack's layers mimic properties of our planet's crust.



### What you need:

- 1 cup rolled oats
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup nut butter (divided)
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup chocolate chips
- Microwave-safe bowl
- Silicone mini baking cups

### What you do:

1. Combine the oats and  $\frac{1}{3}$  cup of the nut butter. Mix until oats stick together.
2. Place 2 teaspoons of oat mixture in each baking cup. Press with a spoon. Freeze for 10 minutes.
3. Spread remaining nut butter atop the cups. Freeze for 10 more minutes.
4. Microwave the chocolate chips 30 seconds. Stir and keep heating for 30-second intervals until melted.
5. Spread melted chocolate atop the cups. Freeze until chocolate is firm.
6. Remove from the molds and enjoy! Refrigerate leftovers in an airtight container.
