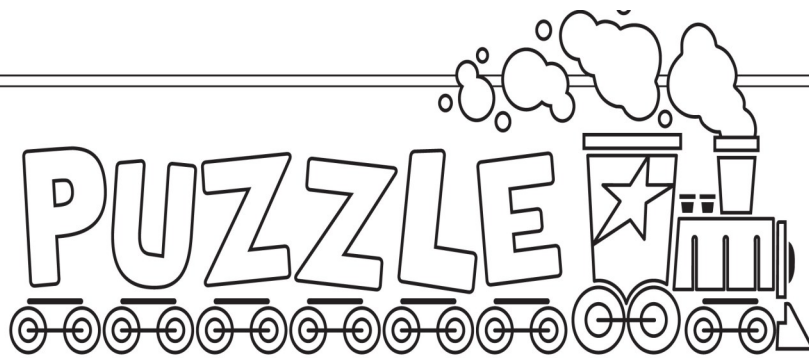

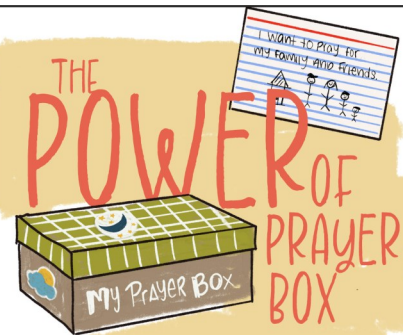
JESUS TRAVELED TO MANY PLACES

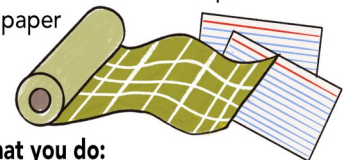
