"May you be made strong with all the strength that comes from his glorious power, so that you may have all endurance and patience, joyfully ¹² giving thanks to the Father, who has enabled you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the light." Colossians 1:11-12

You ever have a day that just, from the moment you wake up, you know is just going to be a slog? Giving what may be difficult to give. **Time & Talents** from the heart in an act of Faith.


Ultimately, first fruits are intended to help us build a deeper, more intimate relationship with God through our own **faith**.






