"May you be made strong with all the strength that comes from his glorious power, so that you may have all endurance and patience, joyfully ¹² giving thanks to the Father, who has enabled you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the light." Colossians 1:11-12

You ever have a day that just, from the moment you wake up, you know is just going to be a slog? You may have even slept well, but from the very moment your alarm goes off and you rise from your bed, you just feel tired. Maybe even beaten down a bit. You just know you are going to have to *endure*, just going to have to get through. It is even worse when you know you have a busy day ahead too. You get this thought in your head like, "Ugh. 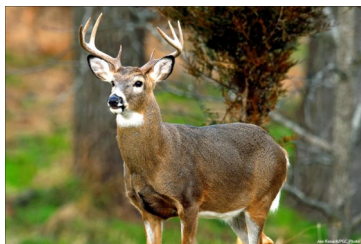

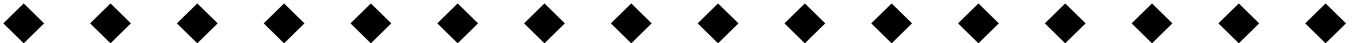

Celebrate the season of gratitude by creating a colorful Thankful decoration.

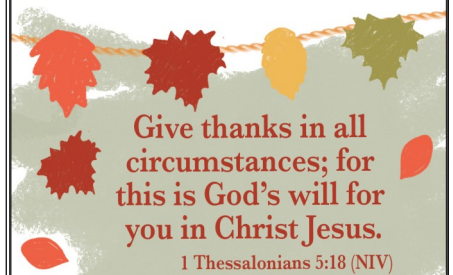
What you need:
