In the movie “The Sound of Music,” Maria, played by Julie Andrews, sings the song, “My Favorite Things” to the children during a storm to calm their fears. It is a cute song that also helps her to bond them together as she has just started as their nanny. But favorite things have always been something that comforts us in the midst of our fears and troubles. Think about your favorite stuffed animal that you might have had as a kid or that maybe your child has right now. Or maybe you had a favorite blanket. Do you have a favorite sweatshirt or pair of pajama pants that you always wear now when you have a bad day or that you put on when you are sick? Do you have a favorite thing to eat or drink when you are sick or when something bad happens that comforts you? A favorite movie or TV show or song you put on to pick you up when you need it? Favorite things lift us up when we need it.

It is one of the reasons why I wanted to do “My Favorite Bible Verse” as our Lenten theme this year. But I didn’t want to use my favorite, which is Psalm 23 (and no one actually suggested that one either). As some of you submitted your favorite, you even gave me a little glimpse of why. These verses were verses of comfort and hope, of inspiration and guidance. And that is why I wanted to use them. They are like all of our favorite things, something that we turn to in times of fear and grief, suffering and anxiety; but also something we turn to in times of joy, celebration, and thanksgiving. I know I do that with my favorite verse.

Most of all, I hope that you will continue to turn to scripture to give you comfort and hope in the midst of life and be reminded that you are loved by your Savior Jesus Christ. 
